

Press Release from Jefferson County Parks and Recreation District No. 2

The Board of Commissioners for Jefferson County Parks and Recreation District No. 2 aka Brinnon Parks and Recreation District, are accepting letters of interest for Commissioner, Position No. 5. Letters of interest will be accepted until the position is filled. Letters of interest that are received by the end of the month will be reviewed at the next regular or special meeting. At that time, the Board will review letters of interest, interview candidates and consider making an appointment.

Candidates must be registered voters in Voting Precinct No. 204 (the Brinnon area). Candidates will be invited to attend the meeting with their letter of interest that must be submitted a week in advance. We ask that interested parties provide a brief introduction and reasons for seeking the commissioner position.

The Board would like to remind the community that our District is an important asset for the Brinnon area. 2018 accomplishments include: a collaboration with Emerald Towns Alliance and the community to process and sell shrimp; a collaboration with the Pleasant Harbor Marina to provide swimming and other recreational activities to the children of the Brinnon area; and an art and wine fundraiser at Pleasant Harbor. For the remainder of the year we plan to sponsor a kayak training event for the children of Brinnon, a collaboration with Kayak Brinnon. To succeed we need community participation and commitment.
